**Emergency Response and Recovery - Disaster Services:** Responds to more than 600 local disasters yearly, ranging from single-family house fires to large-scale emergencies such as tornadoes, floods, chemical spills and gas explosions. Trained disaster volunteers, on-call 24 hours a day/7 days a week, provide emergency assistance to disaster victims such as assessing their disaster-caused needs and providing them with help to re-establish their lives.

**Armed Forces Emergency Services and International Social Services:** Serves as the emergency communications link between military personnel and their families (24 hours a day/7 days a week). Verifies emergency leave information. In certain emergencies, financial aid is available to veterans and their dependents. Facilitates restoration of communications and family reunification in some international refugee situations. Provides international tracing services to reunite families separated by war, civil unrest or disaster.

**Emergency Preparedness for Adults and Youth:** Offers lifesaving classes in First Aid, CPR, automatic external defibrillation, HIV/AIDS awareness and Aquatics, as well as free courses in volunteer disaster response. Workplace Safety programs provide employee courses that help meet OSHA safety standards such as CPR, first aid, back injury prevention and disease transmission prevention. Youth programs that build skills among preschool through high school youth in a variety of safety and health courses such as, babysitter's training, first aid and gun avoidance. Other services include, free community disaster education programs, which educate the public on how to prevent and better prepare for disasters.

**Emergency Planning:** The Dallas Area Chapter is intimately involved in our community's response preparations for all potential disasters with an increasing emphasis on terrorism. Chapters strengthen ties with their local, state and federal counterparts by their response efforts on a daily basis. The Red Cross is an essential member of the first responder community, helping the public plan for possible emergencies, as well as responding to human needs after a disaster.

**Volunteer Opportunities** are available in all of the above areas.

The Dallas Area Red Cross serves an eleven county community service area: Collin, Dallas, Delta, Denton, Ellis, Hopkins, Hunt, Kaufman, Rains, Rockwall, and Van Zandt.
